“LIBERTY LET’S ROLL” TOUR TO REMEMBER THE ALAMO

Striking forth from Idaho with the passion and purpose embodied by the heroes of the Alamo, the eight-foot cast bronze sculpture, “Liberty let’s Roll!” will be exhibited next to this historical American icon of freedom in San Antonio, Texas.

“We want Americans to remember the horrific events associated with 9/11 and to rekindle and restore the love of freedom that was so prevalent following that day of national tragedy.” Said Irene Deely, the artist who created the sculpture and the moving force behind the “Liberty Let’s Roll!” campaign.

The striking sculpture, a slightly modernized version of the statue of Liberty employing a Kung-Fu-style kick – along with the titled moniker “Liberty Let’s Roll!” inspired by the challenge uttered by United airlines flight 93 passenger Todd Beamer – will help “Americans realize that we can either be victims of our circumstances or kick through the obstacles that confront liberty and freedom.

The 1000 pound, 8 foot tall cast bronze sculpture has scheduled stops along the West Coast before heading to Texas. ABC Television’s New York affiliated recorded the sailing of the sculpture around the Statue of Liberty as guest of the National Park Service.

Due to the enthusiastic response of the first tour where it was invited onto various military posts, art galleries, public libraries and national parks, Deely is motivated to share the message with more people. It will arrive at the Alamo for a one day exhibit on June 24th and take part in several more exhibitions in Texas throughout its year long stay.
