Nationwide Tour to Re-awaken the American Spirit Shows a Different Side of Liberty

(Boise, Idaho – June 2009) A grassroots organization seeking to invigorate the freedom in us all, in life, love and the pursuit of happiness takes their version of “Lady Liberty” on the road.

An 8 foot tall, slightly modernized version of the Statue of Liberty, complete with a Kung-Fu type kick, will make its second journey out of Boise, and trek down the West Coast to the Alamo hoping to inspire those who see it to continue to kick through barriers, overcome obstacles and achieve their dreams. The first journey, in July 2008, culminated in a trip to Liberty Island to meet her big sister and was featured in numerous live broadcasts and media coverage.

“Liberty Let’s Roll” had its inception in the continued after-effects of 9-11 and was physically molded, welded and formed through the infinite talent of local Boise artist extraordinaire, Irene Deely.

Deely, owner of the Woman of Steel Gallery (Garden City, Idaho), wants to encourage people not to give up no matter the circumstance, so she created the statue to relay all she feels about freedom, independence and reaching for dreams.

“We can either be victims of our circumstance or kick through the obstacles. If Lady Liberty were a person, she would not be sitting around,” stated Deely.

Getting a nation to change their ways may not be an easy feat, but Deely is convinced her statue, and the message behind it, will show people that even during the most trying of economical times, we are a resilient nation.

June 7th kicks-off the journey, with music, food, pictures with Liberty and a preview of Deely’s upcoming book release at “A Novel Adventure” 906 W. Main St., Boise, Idaho. The general public will also have an opportunity to share their thoughts on freedom to be included in her book.
